INSTALLATION AND OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS



INTRODUCTION

The 3412 200 Amp DC Current Transformer is designed to measure DC currents of -200A to +200A and provide a voltage output that can be measured on a suitably equipped Oceanic Systems measuring device such as the 3410.

SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

This unit should only be installed by a person competent and experienced in working on electrical systems on boats. Before beginning work the battery should be disconnected to avoid the risk of a short circuit, a fire or an explosion. Before drilling any holes to mount the unit or run the cabling always make sure it is safe to do so.

LOCATION AND INSTALLATION

The power cable to be measured must be fed through the ring of the 3412 and the power cable should be cable tied to the projection below the ring. Note that the power cable should be run so that when it is discharging from the battery the current goes in the direction of the discharge arrow. If this is incorrect the unit will display charging when discharging and vice versa. The attached signal cable should be run to the 3410 making sure that it is supported and protected between the two devices. Please note that the signal cable should be shortened to provide a point to point connection. The signal cable must NOT be lengthened as that will introduce interference into the unit.

SIGNAL CABLE WIRING

The signal cable wires are as follows:

Wire Colour	Description
Red	+5v power to unit
White	Voltage output from unit
Black	Ground to unit
Green	Identifier from unit

CALIBRATION & SETUP

The module requires no calibration.

TROUBLE SHOOTING

No Voltage output	Check wiring is correct
Output not accurate	Ensure current transformer is away from strong magnetic fields
